### **Peak View Mobile Assessment Question and Answer Sheet**

**Q. Who can request a Mobile Assessment?**

A. Private Provider Office Groups, ie. Internal Med, Pediatrician's, Family Practice, Urgent Cares

**Q. How do I initiate a referral for a Mobile Assessment?**

A. You can call 719-444-8484 and speak to our Admissions Team as well as fax over the PVBH's Fax Referral Form and any supporting clinical documentation. After receipt of supporting documentation and review for criteria our assessor will call you to set-up a mobile assessment appointment

**Q. Which programs will you assess for?**

A. Child, Adolescent, Adult and Senior Inpatient level of care for crisis assessments

**Q. Who will conduct the Mobile Assessment?**

A. Your dedicated mobile assessor, Denise Warren LPC

**Q. Do you provide direct transport for an admission?**

A. Peak View will make arrangements for direct secured transportation to our facility

**Q. What days and times are you available to conduct Mobile Assessments?**

A. Monday—Friday during business hours

**Q. What about on nights and weekends and holidays?**

A. You will always be able to make a direct referral to the hospital by calling 719-444-8484 through our Assessment Team 24/7

**Q. What are some common reasons that I would make a Mobile Assessment Referral?**

A. Patients that may be showing signs of anxiety, extreme mood swings, withdrawing, combative/aggressive behaviors associated with a behavioral health diagnosis and dementia/Alzheimer's, depressive symptoms due to grief/loss or others situational matters, active hallucinations due to a behavioral health diagnosis, signs of being in danger to self or others, or for medication management
