

SENIOR INPATIENT PROGRAM

Peak View offers two separate therapeutic 16-bed senior adult units addressing the needs of seniors with psychiatric challenges including depression, bipolar disorder, psychosis and co-occurring disorders. Symptoms can also include behaviors complicated by memory care challenges.

The Senior Inpatient Program is focused on providing exceptional treatment and support through an inter-disciplinary team approach within a comfortable environment. Peak View is licensed by the State of Colorado and is Joint Commissioned Accredited.

WHO QUALIFIES

Ages 55+, male and female

Medicare, Tricare, Medicaid and most commercial insurances
(Peak View will call to get authorization)

REFERRAL SYMPTOMS

Hallucinations, delusions or paranoia
Potential danger to self or others
Suicidal/homicidal ideations or attempts
Sudden change in ability to attend daily activities
Failure of lower level of care
Noncompliance with prescribed meds

Group, family and individual therapy
Psychiatric services (medication management)
Treatment Planning
Psycho-Educational Program

Therapeutic Group Activities
